

“WOMEN, PEACE AND SECURITY”

On 31st October 2000, the UN Security Council unanimously passed
Resolution 1325

For the first time in its 50 year history, the UN Security Council acknowledged not only that ***‘peace is inextricably linked with equality between men and women’*** but that *‘the equal access and full participation of women in power structures and their full involvement in all efforts for the prevention and resolution of conflicts are essential for the maintenance and promotion of peace and security.’*

The resolution calls for:

- **Participation of women in peace processes**
- **Gender training in peacekeeping operations**
- **Protection of women and girls and respect for their rights**
- **Gender mainstreaming in the reporting and implementation systems of the UN relating to conflict, peace and security.**
